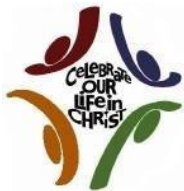

2023 MASS BOOK

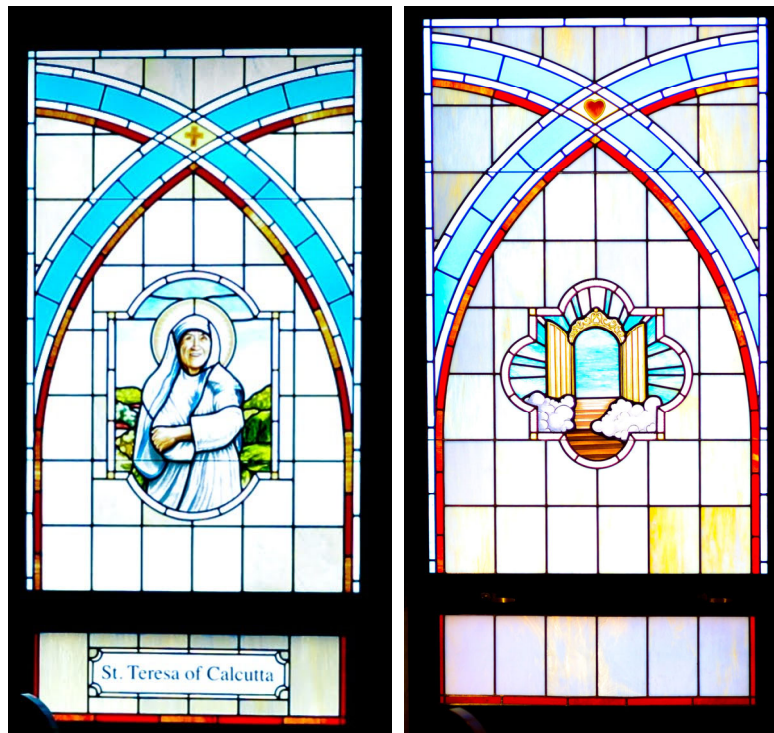
The 2023 Mass book is now open.

Mass Intentions for Masses are still available through the end of 2022. Consider an intention as a birthday, anniversary or even a thank-you gift. A mass intention is a wonderful way to show someone that you care!



- Masks are recommended, not required.
- All pews are used. A section on the side aisle of pews nearest the music on the east side of the church will be reserved for those people who wish to social distance and wear masks.
- If it is your preference to receive Holy Communion on the tongue, we ask that you sit on the left (east) side of the church in either of the sections where the priest typically distributes Communion. It is also requested that you come up at the end of the Communion line so the priest has the opportunity to sanitize his hands as he distributes the Eucharist.
- Holy water is once again in the fonts.
- The Sign of Peace should be shared without physical contact.
- There will not be distribution of the Precious Blood.

St. Teresa of Calcutta, was born **Agnes Gonxha Bojaxhiu** on August 27, 1910, Skopje, Maced., Ottoman Empire and died on September 5, 1997, Calcutta, India. The daughter of a grocer, she became a nun and went to India as a young woman. After studying nursing, she moved to the slums of Calcutta. In 1948 she founded her order, the Order of the Missionaries of Charity, which served the blind, the aged, the disabled, and the dying. In 1963 the Indian government awarded her the Padmashri (“Lord of the Lotus”) for her services to the people of India, and in 1971 Pope Paul VI awarded her the first Pope John XXIII Peace Prize. In 1979 she received the Nobel Prize for Peace. Although in her later years she suffered from a worsening heart condition, Mother Teresa continued to serve the poor and sick. Her order included hundreds of centres in more than 90 countries, with some 4,000 nuns and hundreds of thousands of lay workers. The process to declare her a saint began within two years of her death, and Pope John Paul II issued a special dispensation to expedite the process. She was beatified on Oct. 19, 2003, reaching the ranks of the blessed in the shortest time in the church’s history.

The symbol chosen for St. Teresa of Calcutta is the gates to heaven. She was a model on earth as to how to live a saintly life devoted towards those in need.

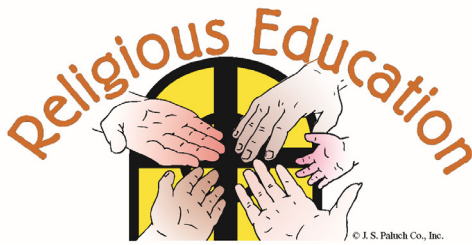

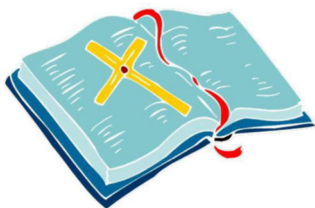
2022-23 RE Registration materials are posted on the RE website and are also available in the IC Rectory Office. Carefully complete all the required information.

All liturgical ministers, Eucharistic Ministers, Lectors, Greeters and Choir Members must be registered on **Virtus** if they wish to continue serving in these vital ministries, as we are now in contact with minor children.

A current **background check** must be on file, **diocesan policies** on the sexual abuse of minors must be read and **acknowledged** and a **volunteer application** must be completed.

Please sign into your **Virtus** account www.virtus.org and check the "Summary" tab to verify whether you are compliant. The summary tab will indicate which items need to be addressed for full compliance.

If you do not yet have a **Virtus** account, please go to IC website's main page and click on the Virtus / Protecting God's Children image, which will direct you to instructions for establishing an account.

If you do not remember where or when you took your Protecting God's Children workshop, please contact Pam Stefik at 630-530-3497. Do not guess at the location or date, as your account cannot be processed with incorrect information.

Individuals who do not have a **Virtus** account or fail to submit the required information will not be scheduled until they are in full compliance and will be moved to inactive status. 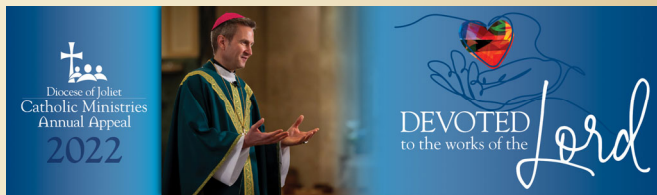

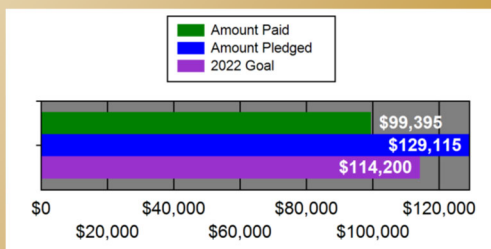
