

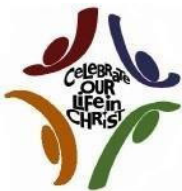

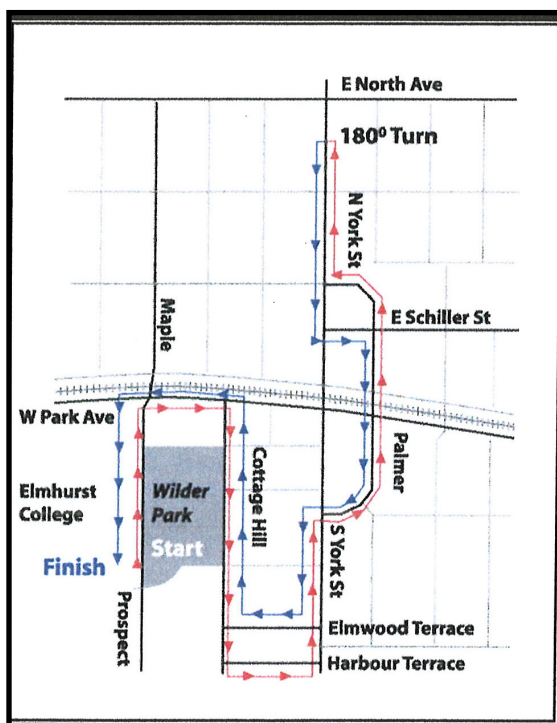
The 2023 Mass book is now open.

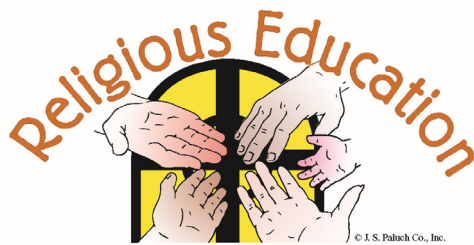

A current **background check** must be on file, **diocesan policies** on the sexual abuse of minors must be read and **acknowledged** and a **volunteer application** must be completed.

Please sign into your **Virtus** account www.virtusonline.org and check the "Summary" tab to verify whether you are compliant. The summary tab will indicate which items need to be addressed for full compliance.

If you do not yet have a **Virtus** account, please go to IC website's main page and click on the Virtus / Protecting God's Children image, which will direct you to instructions for establishing an account.

If you do not remember where or when you took your Protecting God's Children workshop, please contact Pam Stefik at 630-530-3497. Do not guess at the location or date, as your account cannot be processed with incorrect information.

Individuals who do not have a **Virtus** account or fail to submit the required information will not be scheduled until they are in full compliance and will be moved to inactive status. 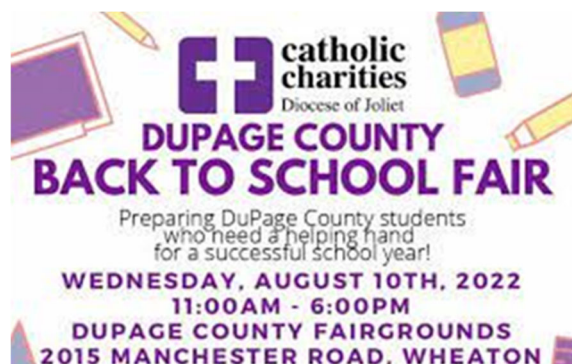

What's Next? What does the rest of the Synod process look like?
Sixteen regional teams will work on drafting regional synthesis reports from the individual diocesan reports, which then will contribute to a national synthesis phase in which a national writing team will draft a complete report that will be submitted to the Vatican in August 2022. Following the conclusion of the local consultation phase, the Vatican will use the synthesized reports from bishops' conferences around the world to develop a working document to guide continental or regional ecclesial assemblies that will take place by March 2023. Those assemblies will produce another set of documents that will help in the drafting of a second working document for the Synod of Bishops in October 2023.

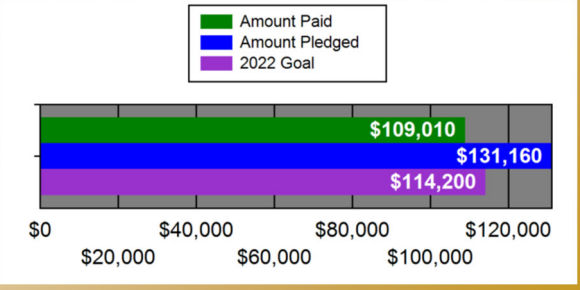
