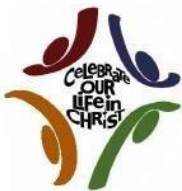

My son Caleb has a rare form of muscular dystrophy that renders him 100% dependent for all his daily needs and he uses a wheelchair for mobility.

I am reaching out to our Catholic faith community for volunteers as a counselor at **MDA camp, be blessed in ways no other opportunity could afford, and answer God's call to service.**

The camp is a sleep away camp that serves young people ages 8-17 who have any form of muscular dystrophy. It is an opportunity for both the camper and counselor to be blessed by the experiences and events offered only at this kind of a camp. There are Lurie Children's Hospital doctors and nurses on site the entire week!

My son, Caleb has attended this camp since he was 5 years old (before the age was changed to 8). It's his favorite week of the year!!! He is now 13.5 and has benefited tremendously from the camp experience: staying in a cabin; fishing; on-site petting zoo; firefighters for a day come and play with the kids using their fire-hoses to entertain; swimming pool on site; camp fires; zip lining; horse back riding and breaking bread with others like himself.

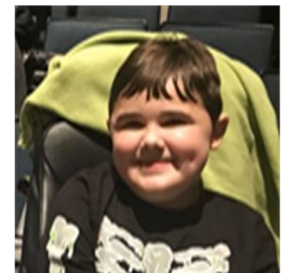
Each camper has a 1:1 counselor; we are in need of more counselors this year!

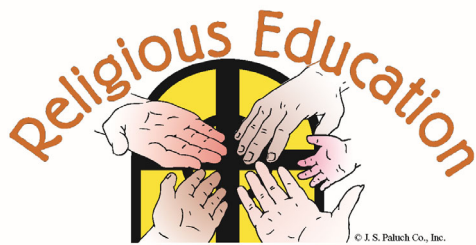
All the male campers, over the age of 10, have a male counselor.

Individuals who do not have a **Virtus** account or fail to submit the required information will not be scheduled until they are in full compliance and will be moved to inactive status. 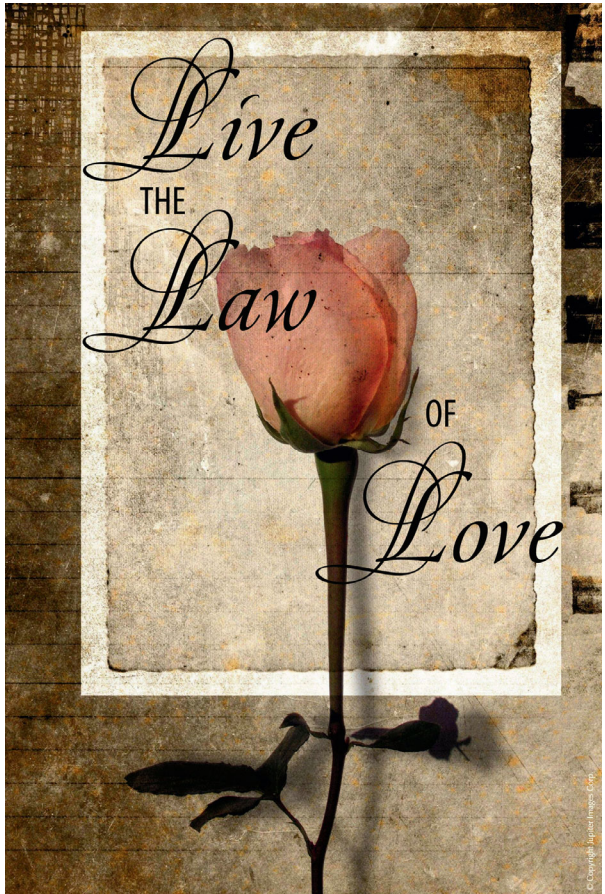

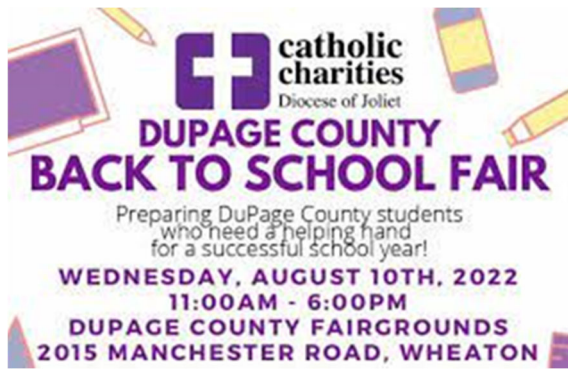

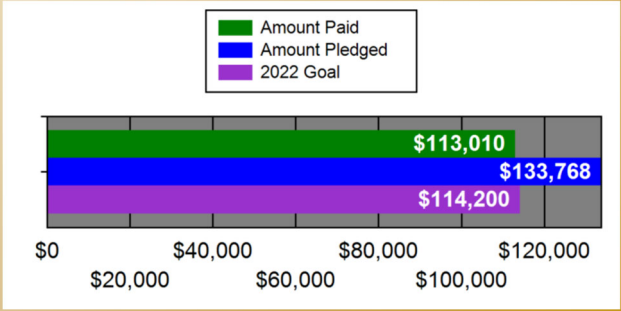
