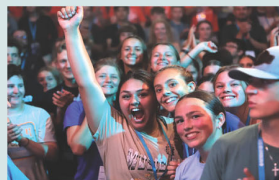
Joliet Youth Day

As part of the celebration of the National Eucharistic Revival, over the last three weekends Fr. Tom and Fr. Jeremy presented a sermon series on the Eucharist.

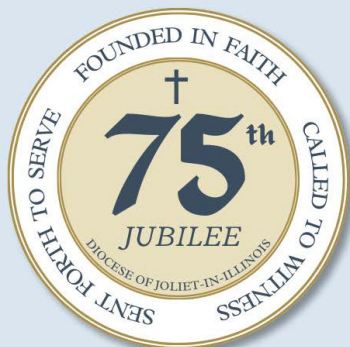
Week 1 — “This is My Body” — How do we know that the Eucharist is **really** Jesus’ Body and Blood? This homily tells the story of Chapter 6 from the Gospel of John and how Jesus himself teaches his followers about his Real Presence in the Eucharist.

Week 2 — “Do This in Memory of Me” — One of the biggest reasons why Catholics **don’t** always go to Mass is because “they don’t get anything out of it.” This homily explains how Mass is not so much about the fellowship, the readings, the music, the homily, or even the Eucharist. Mass is about coming face to face with the God who has saved us.

Week 3 — “Never Let Me Be Parted from You” — Before Jesus ascended into heaven, he told his disciples, “Behold, I am with you always, even to the end of the age.” The Eucharist is a foretaste of heaven, and every time we receive Holy Communion, Jesus is saying to us: “This is how I will stay close to you here on earth until I am with you forever in heaven.”

These Sunday homilies are posted on Spotify in case you would like to refer back to them or share them with someone you know. 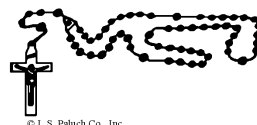

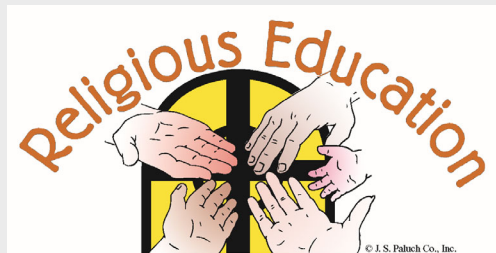

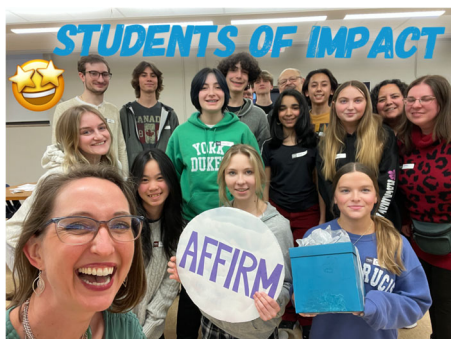
