



Pentecost Sunday comes 50 days after Easter, and it celebrates the beginning of the Church. At that time, the resurrected Jesus had been with the apostles to give instructions for their upcoming mission. He tells them they “will be baptized with the Holy Spirit.” This Holy Spirit baptism will empower them to be His witnesses throughout the world—everywhere and eventually to everyone.

“When the day of Pentecost had come, they were all together in one place. And suddenly there came from heaven a noise like a violent rushing wind, and it filled the whole house where they were sitting. And there appeared to them tongues as of fire distributing themselves, and they rested on each one of them.” (Acts 2:1-30)


Pentecost started the mission of the Church to include everyone, Jewish and non-Jewish, into God’s family. This is the reason why the “speaking in tongues” miracle is so important to bringing all humanity to God.

“I will also make you a light of the nations, so that my salvation may reach to the end of the earth” (Isa49:6)). God’s dwelling place is in people who bear witness to the risen Jesus by choosing to live in his way of love. The world will know God through this community of people, who love God and others, like Jesus does.

Pentecost shows us that God now dwells within the community of Jesus’ followers. This living temple is made of people who follow Jesus’ teachings of how to love and bless one another. In this sense, Pentecost marks the beginning of a new world.

As we enter the third year of the Eucharist Revival, whose theme is ‘Missionary Sending’, we are reminded that through the Eucharist, we are sent forth with the flame of divine charity to be the hands, feet, and heart of Christ in the world. All Catholics are invited into a renewed encounter with Jesus Christ in the Eucharist.

Today, 11 students from our high school were fully received into the church. As a parish family, let us prayerfully journey with and congratulate those who received the Sacraments of Initiation. 




